The IDEA Amendments also limited when attorneys fees can be awarded under the IDEA. Fees cannot be provided for participation by an attorney in IEP meetings. They are also not available for mediation sessions prior to filing for a due process hearing. Attorney fees can be reduced if the parents attorney does not provide appropriate information to the school district regarding the possible action.
